COMPETITION SCHEDULE, GROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

I. IMPORTANT SCHEDULE

- _____ : Registration and submission of documents, via email to amme117@yahoo.com
- _____ : WEIGH IN (Weight/Height verification will be conducted by the authorized weigh in officials). Athletes who will not meet their submitted weight will be disqualified. NO ALLOWANCES ON WEIGHT will be given.
- _____ : Competition proper – 9am onwards

II. EVENTS

KYORUGI – (JUNIORS AND MIDGETS DIVISION)

POOMSAE – (JUNIORS DIVISION ONLY)

III. SCOPE OF COMPETITION

Only members of the WNCAA may join the competition.

IV. QUALIFICATION OF PARTICIPANTS

- A. All contestants must be bonafide students of the school they are representing, screened by the WNCAA screening committee and registered members of the Philippine Taekwondo Association.

B. Open to JUNIOR (14 – 18 years old) and MIDGET born year 2011 (13 years old and below) DIVISIONS ONLY. Each school may field in a MAXIMUM OF 2 PLAYERS PER WEIGHT/HEIGHT CATEGORY.

C. All listed members of Armed Forces of the Philippines, National Team, UAAP athletes are disqualified to join the competition.

V. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Each school must submit the gallery folder to the WNCAA office for screening.

VI. METHOD OF COMPETITION

A. The competition shall be ONE (1) minute per round with 20 seconds interval in between round and will use the Best-of-Three System, (BO3).

B. There will be 2 courts set-up for the competition. Three judges, one chief referee, and one head of court. They shall score the contestants based on Taekwondo competition rules and regulations.

C. There shall be no changes in the position of the judges until the stage of the competition for each division is completed.

III. FORMAT OF COMPETITION

Contestants may be fielded in any of the following categories.

B. Junior / Midget divisions will be divided into two classes/groups

- a. Novice division - yellow and blue belt class
- b. Advance division - red, brown and black belt class

VI. PROTEST, ARBITRATION AND PENALTIES

- A. Stipulations of the WNCAA Taekwondo Championships shall prevail in all cases. In cases where there are no provisions in the WNCAA Taekwondo Tournament Rules, the PTA rules and regulations shall apply.
- B. Any school or coach who violates the WNCAA rules will undergo investigation and will be subjected to sanctions of the WNCAA.

VII. AWARDS

A. Medals shall be awarded to the winners in each category as follows:

Champion - Gold Medal

Second Place - Silver Medal

Third Place (2) - Bronze Medal

MVP (1) - Gold Medal

B. Trophies shall be awarded to the school based on medals won both in novice and advance division - gold, silver, bronze. In case where there are schools with the same number of medals, the factors to be considered to break the tie are:

- a. number of fights won
- b. number of participants fielded by a school

There will be an overall champion for both kyorugi and poomsae events.

C. MVP Award will be given for each division.

VIII. GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR THE COMPETITION

1. Competition Codes of Conduct: The PTA Competition Codes of Conduct shall be strictly enforced.
2. Year 2018 Resolutions: Resolutions made by the PTA Tournament Directors during the 2018 technical conference on competition management shall be enforced.
3. Competition Rules: For all other matters not provided for in these ground rules, the WTF Competition Rules and Interpretation's latest revision shall apply.
4. Competition Uniform: All contestants are encouraged to use the official kyorugi competition Taekwondo uniform (dobok) of the Philippine Taekwondo Association.

NOTE: Use of the "PHILIPPINES" print on the uniform is reserved for members of the National Taekwondo Team and for those who have represented the country in international competitions. Otherwise, such usage is strictly prohibited.

5. Competition Equipment: Only brands accredited / approved by the PTA shall be allowed / approved for use. The contestants shall provide their own competition equipment (head protector, body protector, arm & shin guards, groin guard, hand & foot gloves).
6. Mouth Guard: The use of the mouth guard shall be required. For the children's division, the mouth guard shall be required for heights of 128 cm and higher. Mouth guard color must be white or transparent only.
7. Coaches' Attire: Coaches are required to wear collared shirt and coach's vest (attire: smart-casual).

No slippers, caps, sleeveless shirts will be allowed.

8. Referees: Only National and Regional Referees who have passed the course for the current rules shall serve during the competition. They shall serve full-time.
